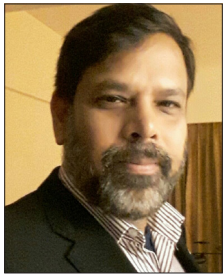

### DIAGNOSIS, TREATMENT PLANNING AND EXECUTION

Dental implants are a mainstream treatment modality in modern dentistry. Today the clinician as well as the patient has high expectations from the outcome of implant restorations both in function and aesthetics. In order to achieve the same one needs a thorough case evaluation so that one reaches the correct diagnosis of the challenge presented and thereby arrive at the most appropriate treatment plan for that case. The speaker will discuss in detail the case evaluation, algorithm for arriving at the correct diagnosis, treatment plan formulation and presentation.

### PROTHETIC COMPLICATIONS IN IMPLANT DENTISTRY: ETIOLOGY, PREVENTION AND MANAGEMENT

In modern dentistry replacement of missing teeth by dental implants is a given treatment modality and no longer just an option. More and more implants are being placed with higher success rates and long term predictability for surgical success. The desire to load the implants immediately in high number of cases as compared to earlier treatment protocols has put the onus of the long term prosthetic success on the clinicians. With the increasing longevity, the long term complications especially prosthetic are being experienced in higher numbers and many of such cases can be classified as prosthetic failures.

### CURRENT PROTOCOL FOR IMMEDIATE IMPLANT PLACEMENT

For a predictable outcome, placing immediate implants following extraction of teeth, the diagnosis and treatment planning of the case in hand must be precise. There are five key aspects to consider in the decision making process to help prevent blunders that can lead to difficult esthetic situations.

Let us explore those five salient points one by one in making immediate implant placement hassle free from start to finish, to bring about ideal prosthetic loading in terms of orientation, esthetics and function.

### IMPRESSION TECHNIQUE HANDS-ON

Transferring the Implant positions from the mouth to the working model is critical to the success of Implant Restorations. The hands-on will help you understand how to ensure precision in Implant impression making as well as how to verify the accuracy.
